



British Para-Swimming Entry Guidelines for the World Para Swimming World Series

If you wish to compete for your club at a World Para Swimming World Series (with the exception of the British Para Swimming International Meet (BPSIM) the criteria below must be met:

General:

1. To compete overseas you are required to complete an International Permit and Clearance Form <http://www.swimming.org/asa/clubs-and-members/frequently-asked-questions/faq-international-permits/172/> no later than 28 days prior to the World Para Swimming World Series Event.
 - All guidelines and criteria must be met by swimmers, coaches and team managers as outlined on the British Swimming website and International Permit and Clearance Form.
2. You will be notified within 5 working days whether your request has been approved.
3. All swimmers wishing to enter must have a 2018 IPC License.
4. All swimmers wishing to be entered must be IPC classified with a: C, R or R with fixed review date status. The only exception to this is a swimmer on a British Para-Swimming World Class Programme requiring an IPC classification that is travelling with either a Great Britain or Home Nation representative team.

Entries:

1. Entries for events in which the SDMS system is the only means of entry e.g. Denmark must be submitted to: paraswimming@swimming.org no later than 5 working days prior to the entry deadline.
 - The club/swimmer takes full responsibility for their own payment of entries, accommodation, transport and any other associated costs directly to the Local Organising Committee (LOC) - not via British Para-Swimming.
 - Entries must be checked by yourself. British Para-Swimming accepts no responsibility for incorrect entries.
 - Entries will be made under your club name.
2. Entries for events in which they can be made directly to the LOC must be done so on confirmation of your International Permit and Clearance to compete overseas.
 - The club/swimmer takes full responsibility for completing their own entries by the required deadline and for payment of entries, accommodation, transport and any other associated costs directly to the Local Organising Committee (LOC) - not via British Para-Swimming.
 - Entries must be made under your club name. **Under no circumstances should you enter under Great Britain.**
