Guide to Entering Online

British Athletes

- 1. Follow the online entry page link **HERE.**
 - Enter your membership number or surname in the box.
- 2. Providing you have updated your photo information in your biog, a list with the events you have qualified in will appear ticked.
- 3. Untick any events which you do not wish to enter.
- 4. Payment is via debit or credit card; please follow the PayPal payment instructions. You do not need a PayPal account to do this. Your entry will not be complete until you receive a confirmation of payment email from Paypal.

Unlicensed International Nationally Classified Athletes

- 1. Complete the excel spreadsheet entry form for all Athletes that can be found under the Athlete and Coaches tab **HERE**.
- 2. All Athlete entries must be done by the respective NPC.
- 3. The entry form must be sent to isobel.griffiths@swimming.org.
- 4. All Athlete entries will be invoiced to the NPC following the entry deadline.

British Para-Swimming International Winter Meet entries shall open on at 15:00hours GMT on 13th December 2023.

All entries for the British Para-Swimming International Winter Meet shall be received by no later than 12:00hours GMT on 12th January 2024.

Entries without completed payment will not be accepted. No entries are permitted after this time.

Coaches/Chaperones/Team Staff Accreditation

All Team Staff accreditations are issued at £26 each.

British

Any British Coaches, Chaperones and Team Staff requiring poolside access must purchase a pass. In order to do this, you must have proof of your DBS check and safeguarding certificate.

SS and SW members purchase a pass <u>here</u>
Sports Science/Sports Medicine staff purchase a pass <u>here</u>

Accreditations will be sent via email in PDF format upon completion of purchase. **These must be printed off and brought to the event.**

International

For the British Para-Swimming International Winter Meet, all International Coaches, Chaperones and Team Staff requiring poolside access must apply for a pass. Full names and accreditation photographs for all International Coaches, Chaperones and Team Staff must be sent to isobel.griffiths@swimming.org by 19th January 2024. Evidence of child protection checks or certificate of good conduct must also be sent to the above email address for each Staff accreditation application to ensure approval.

Please note if International Coaches, Chaperones and Team Staff have applied for World Series accreditation they **do not** need to apply for a British Para-Swimming International Winter Meet accreditation.

All accreditations will be invoiced to NPCs alongside any athlete entries.

Accreditation will be available for collection by one member of the NPC from the Sport Information Desk.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

Session Times

Heats will start at 09:30 and finals at 17:00. Estimated session finish times will be in the confirmation pack.

Training

Training will take place at Aberdeen Aquatics Centre for all competitors on 29th – 31st January 2024. If a training booking system is used, information on how to booking time slots and the daily quantity that can booked per athlete will be communicated in due course.

More information will follow in the confirmation pack.

Warm Up and Swim Down

The structure of Warm up will be determined by entry numbers.

Competition Warm-Up will take place in both the 10 lane x 50 Competition Pool and in the 6 lane x 25m Diving Pool.

Additional warm up and swim down will take place in the Diving Pool throughout each session.

Doping Control

Swimmers are warned that random doping control may take place during these Championships. The Anti-Doping control / processes will be carried out in full accordance with the IPC Anti-Doping Code and the IPC Doping Control Agreement. More information can be found here.

<u>COMPETITION VENUE – ACCESSIBILITY INFORMATION</u>

Aberdeen Aquatics Centre

Accessible car parking spaces are available immediately next to the entrance Aberdeen Aquatics Centre (free for blue badge holders).

A lift is available within Reception to reach the upper level Spectator Balcony.

Accessible toilets, showers and cubicles are available in the Changing Rooms. There is also a hoist to assist users into and out of the Competition Pool.

TECHNICAL MEETING

It is recommended that a representative from all clubs with swimmers entered in this Meet to attend the Technical Meeting. Details of the time and location of the meeting will be confirmed as soon as possible. Clubs are reminded to bring any tapping, starting devices and modified swim suits for approval.

Non-attendance could result in swimmers being disadvantaged or not able to compete due to them or their coach not being aware of any changes required for the running of the competition.

CALL ROOMS AND COMPETITION

Location of the call rooms will be published in due course.

For heats and finals, swimmers must report to the first call-room in accordance with the WPS Rules no later than fifteen (15) minutes prior to the published start time of their respective race.

Swimmers must report to the competition stewards in the call room for heats and finals and follow their direction. It is the swimmer's responsibility to report on time.

Swimmers must enter the Call Room 'race ready' as under normal circumstances having entered the Call Room they should remain in its confines until being led onto the pool deck for their race.

Coaches/chaperones will not be allowed in the call room at any time, except for those swimmers with the relevant classification and exception code allowing Support Staff.

COMPETITION SCHEDULE

SPORT INFORMATION DESK (SID)

A Sport Information Desk will operate at the competition venue on the days of competition, as well as during any scheduled training sessions. It is the primary and only point of distribution for all event related information (i.e., Official communication with teams and liaison between teams and event organisers.

Please note the Start Lists and Withdrawal forms will only be available online.

The Sport Information Desk will be located in the Reception Foyer of the Aberdeen Aquatics Centre.

The opening times of the Sport Information Desk will be confirmed prior to the event.

ATHLETE AND TEAM SEATING

Athletes and Team Officials seating and Team areas will be located in a designated section(s) of the Spectator seating. An additional wheelchair seating area will be available on the pool deck. The location of this area will be confirmed prior to the event.

VICTORY CEREMONIES

Awards Ceremonies will be combined with the World Series Meet.

Awards will be made to the 3 highest BPSP scoring swimmers across the World Series Final A competed in each Event.

Awards will be made to the 3 highest scoring WPS Youth swimmers across all Finals competed in each Event.

An award will be made to the highest BPSP points scoring GBR Swimmer across all Finals competed in each Event.

An award will be made to the highest BPSP points scoring GBR Junior Swimmer

A GBR Junior Swimmer will be 16 years old or younger (Age at 31st December of competition year).

MEDICAL SERVICES

On duty lifeguards will be available at the Venue.

External medical assistance will be provided. A medical doctor will be on site during training and competition as well as a Paramedic, Emergency Medical Technician and Ambulance during competition.

The location of the medical team will be communication prior to the event.

FILMING AND PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

British Swimming are well aware of the wide range of devices including mobile telephones which have photographic and filming capabilities. This enables the capture of both static and moving images. It should be acknowledged that the majority of images taken within a British Swimming setting are appropriate and taken in good faith. However, images of children and adults can be misused, and sharing images widely without consent may betray a confidence or identify of a child or adult, which could present a risk of harm to that individual if common sense procedures are not followed.

Parents and carers of participants under the age of 18 who wish to take images are requested to focus on their own children as much as reasonably possible and to avoid including other children in images, particularly if those images are being shared with family and friends or through social media platforms. Whilst it is acknowledged that parents/carers wish to celebrate the achievements of their own children when taking part in aquatic events, it should be recognised and respected that other parents/carers may not wish for their child's image to be taken and shared in this way.

British Swimming encourage all spectators and participants at British Swimming events to make themselves familiar with the photography and filming arrangements for the event and be vigilant during that event.

British Swimming is committed to ensuring that all children who participate in British Swimming activities are able to take part in an enjoyable, safe environment and be safeguarded from harm. If you have any child safeguarding concerns at the event, please contact an Events Officer immediately to disclose your concerns.
