



2024 EUROPEAN AQUATICS JUNIOR OPEN WATER SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS 12th – 14th July, Vienna, AUSTRIA

SELECTION POLICY

1. POLICY PURPOSE

1.1 This selection policy outlines the process for selecting the team to represent Great Britain at the 2024 European Junior Open Water Swimming Championships in Vienna, Austria, 12th-14th July 2024.

2. PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVE

2.1 The target for the event is to provide a meaningful competitive opportunity in the long-term development of British junior swimmers towards future senior international success.

3. SELECTION EVENT

- 3.1 Selections will be made from performances in the 1500m freestyle event at the 2024 British Swimming Championships, London Aquatics Centre, London, 2nd 7th April 2024 ("the British Championships").
- 3.2 In the event that the British Championships is cancelled, a revised selection policy will be published by the Swimming Leadership Team.

4. TEAM SIZE

- 4.1 Up to four (4) swimmers may be selected, subject to available funding, for the 2024 European Junior Open Water Championships. The total number of swimmers selected will be at the discretion of the Performance Director. There is no obligation to use select the maximum team size.
- 4.2 Swimmers based overseas (outside of the United Kingdom) should take specific note of Clause 7.1 and of the General Conditions of this policy, with specific reference to clauses G3, G8 and G9.

5. AGE ELIGIBILITY

5.1. Athletes born 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010

6. ATHLETE SELECTION

- 6.1. The fastest two male and fastest two female swimmers in the 1500m freestyle at the British Championships will be invited for selection if they have achieved the minimum consideration time in Table 1.
- 6.2 If any of the two male and/or two female swimmers decline their selection invite, the selection panel may consider inviting other swimmers who achieve the minimum consideration time at the British Championships. All male and female swimmers achieving the minimum consideration time at the British Championships will be ranked against this and selection invites prioritised to the next fastest swimmers.
- 6.2 If two male and/or two female swimmers are not selected, the panel reserves the right to select athletes of any gender up to the maximum team size providing swimmers have achieved the minimum consideration time at the British Championships.
- 6.3 Any eligible swimmer achieving selection for the 2024 European Aquatics Junior Championships (pool) may be also be considered for selection for the Open Water Championships.





6.4 Any eligible swimmer achieving selection for the 2024 Paris Olympic Games will not be considered for European Junior Open Water Championships selection.

7. TEAM ASSEMBLY

7.1 All selected swimmers will be required to cover their own travel expenses to the designated assembly point in the UK for travel to the 2024 European Junior Open Water Swimming Championships.

9. ANNOUNCEMENT

8.1. The 2024 European Junior Open Water Championships Team will be announced on, or before Monday 29th April 2024.

SELECTION POLICY GENERAL CONDITIONS

ELIGIBILITY

Swimmers must:

- G1 Be a British citizen and eligible to represent Great Britain as per the World Aquatics rules
- G2 Have completed a Selection Acceptance Form to confirm they will be available to participate by the deadline to be imposed by British Swimming. Failure to do so will be interpreted as non-availability by British Swimming. Selection Acceptance Forms will be provided by British Swimming to qualifying team members.
- G3 Be available to fulfil all team commitments from the time of selection through to the Championships.
- G4 Comply with any other World Aquatics eligibility, including in respect of nationality and/or antidoping.

TEAM COMMITMENTS

All Team members will be required to:

- G5 Comply with the British Swimming Code of Conduct. A breach of the British Swimming Code of Conduct may result in de-selection from the team.
- G6 Adhere to all prescribed travel arrangements which might involve different travel dates to other members of the team.
- G7 Abide by media protocols of the British Swimming Programme. Athletes must only speak to the media about their own performances and group coaches must only comment on performances of swimmers in their group. The Performance Pathway and Distance Lead (swimming) and Performance Director may discuss performances of the entire team. Swimmers must not publicise any information in relation selection-related matters until authorised to do so by the Team Leader.
- G8 Not take holiday or attend overseas camps and/or competitions between the selection trials and the meet for which they have been selected without prior written approval from the Performance Director.
- G9 Make themselves available for all team activities designated by the Performance Pathway and Distance Lead (swimming). No team member will be allowed to leave a national team camp or undertake any activities that are not directly relevant to the team camp programme; this includes any external media, sponsor or social activities. Failure to attend the required activities could result in withdrawal from the team. Under exceptional circumstances, written approval to be excluded from activities may be given by the Performance Director.
- G10 Comply with British Swimming and World Aquatics and European Aquatics swimwear regulations whilst competing at the 2024 European Junior Open Water Championships.

WITHDRAWALS AND REPLACEMENTS

- G11 If for any reason a swimmer is unable or unwilling to fully comply with the Team Commitments (G5 to G10) they may be withdrawn from the team.
- G12 Swimmers becoming unfit due to illness or injury (physical or mental) at any time following their selection must notify British Swimming immediately and will be required to undertake a full medical examination which <u>may</u> result in the swimmer being de-selected from the team at the complete discretion of the GB Head Coach. In the event of injury or illness athletes may be deselected if they pose a risk to themselves, other athletes or team staff as determined by the British Swimming Chief Medical Officer or her designate.





REPLACEMENTS

G13 Replacement of swimmers withdrawn from the team will be considered at the complete discretion of the Performance Pathway and Distance Lead (swimming) in the best interest of the overall team performance.

OTHER

- G14 The World Class Programme Swimming Leadership Team may amend selection policies, within reason at its discretion.
- G15 The Performance Director and Performance Pathway and Distance Lead (swimming) will exercise their authority to ensure that the final selections for the 2024 European Junior Championships team are in line with this policy and will result in the best possible achievements at the 2024 European Junior Open Water Championships.

APPEALS

G16 Any appeals against non-selection must be made to British Swimming in accordance with the British Swimming Team Selection Appeals Procedures. available online at https://www.britishswimming.org/performance/swimming/selection-policies/team-selectionappeals/ Clarke, Associate Director by request from Adam via or email at adam.clarke@swimming.org. Athletes should be aware of the time limits contained in the Procedures, which are designed with the intention of resolving issues expeditiously and fairly.
