

Step 2. Procedure for INAS Classification application



Inas Classification required

Does the swimmer meet the required eligibility criteria of:

- 1. A full scale IQ score of 75 or below
- **2.** Evidence of significant limitations in adaptive behaviour
- 3. Evidence of age of onset before the age of 18

Gather supporting documentation and evidence

- a. Photo with name on reverse
- b. Photograph page of current passport
- c. IQ test & report fully completed & signed and in correct format
- d. Copy of IQ Summary sheet (raw scores).
- e. Adaptive behaviour test & report Fully completed & signed and in correct format.
- f. Copy of Adaptive behaviour Summary sheet (raw scores).
- g. Evidence of Age of onset both documentary if available, but always with summary statement in psychologist reports.
