## SWIMMING SECTION

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## POLICY FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE JURY OF APPEAL FOR ASA NATIONAL EVENTS

- 1. The Event Director to appoint a Chairman of the Jury of Appeal for each event prior to the closing date of entries based on the following criteria:
- 2. Chairman must not have any foreseeable conflict of interest (e.g. may not be a relative of a competitor in the event.)
- 3. The Event Director and Chairman of the Jury of Appeal to appoint the panel members prior to the printing of the programme for the event based on the following criteria:
  - a. Normally at least one Panel member or the Chairman must be familiar with the discipline concerned.
  - b. Panel members must not have any foreseeable conflicts of interest.
- 4. If any Panel member or the Chairman find they have a conflict of interest they should resign with immediate effect and be replaced by a suitably experienced member.
- 5. The Chairman and Panel members may not participate in the organisation or running of the event in any capacity.
- 6. The decision of the Jury of Appeal is final.

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
