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POLICY FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE JURY OF APPEAL FOR ASA NATIONAL EVENTS

1. The Event Director to appoint a Chairman of the Jury of Appeal for each event prior to the closing date of entries based on the following criteria:
2. Chairman must not have any foreseeable conflict of interest (e.g. may not be a relative of a competitor in the event.)
3. The Event Director and Chairman of the Jury of Appeal to appoint the panel members prior to the printing of the programme for the event based on the following criteria:
 - a. Normally at least one Panel member or the Chairman must be familiar with the discipline concerned.
 - b. Panel members must not have any foreseeable conflicts of interest.
4. If any Panel member or the Chairman find they have a conflict of interest they should resign with immediate effect and be replaced by a suitably experienced member.
5. The Chairman and Panel members may not participate in the organisation or running of the event in any capacity.
6. The decision of the Jury of Appeal is final.
