DIVE SHEETS

Divers/Coaches are requested to submit dive sheets electronically, both for their own convenience and to minimize the chance of errors loading the data into the Recording program. Coaches may make bulk submission of dive sheets on behalf of their divers by using the program DiveSheets with which they will already be familiar. Alternatively, individual divers may submit their own dive sheets online. Please agree with your coach which method you should use. To submit your dive sheets online there are two options:

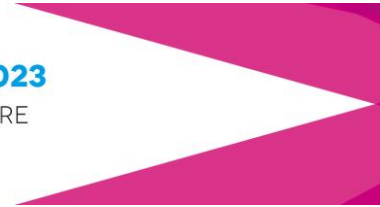
Electronic submissions must be made by 8am on Wednesday 24 May 2023. You will be asked to sign hard copies of these sheets at the venue, available from the Recorders. If neither you nor your Coach are able to use the above electronic methods, you can submit a hard copy of your lists of dives to the Recorders. **The deadline for manual dive sheets is 6pm on Wednesday 24 May 2023.**

EVENT CONDITIONS

(1.0) GENERAL

1.1 British Teams with British eligible divers; have unlimited number of entries, but they must have achieved the qualification standard in the preceding 12 months (See Table 1.2).





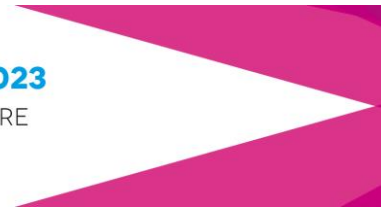
- 1.2 Members of International Federations who are members of British clubs may enter under their British Club, but will follow rules 3.1-3.3
- 1.3 Individual events will follow World Aquatic conditions (See Table 1.1) for 1m and 3m springboard and 10m platform. All platform dives to be performed from the 10m platform.
- 1.4 No dive may be repeated in a list of dives.
- 1.5 Minimum age for competitors is 10 years on 31 December in the year of competition
- 1.6 Synchronised events will be straight finals
- 1.7 Late Entries for all events are allowed up to the start of the technical meeting. All late entries will incur a late entry fee. Except late entries to Synchro. The late entry fee for Synchro will be at the discretion of the Head Coach Olympic Diving.
- 1.8 Divers may compete exclusively in synchronised events.

(2.0) FINALS

- 2.1 Divers will perform their dives, competing in the reverse order of their preliminary rankings.
- 2.2 The 6 highest ranked British divers, regardless of ranking overall in the preliminary will proceed to the final.
- 2.3 The finals can consist of a maximum of 12 divers, ranked from the preliminary event, including any guests (IF) divers, see condition 3.2 and 3.3.
- 2.4 Following rules 3.2 and 3.3 the remaining 6 places in the final will be comprised of the remaining divers in ranked order. This may include divers originally ranked outside the top 12.

GUESTS (International Federation / Club Entries).

- 3.1 Evidence shall be provided, at the time of entry, to confirm that each foreign diver has achieved the recommended standard for the event they are entering.
- 3.2 A maximum of 6 international divers may proceed to the final unless in the preliminary event, there are fewer than 6 British divers. In this case, additional international divers may proceed to the final.



3.3. Individual International Federation Team (Guest) may only qualify a maximum of 2 divers into the final. Multiple club entries from one country will be treated as one International Federation for final qualification purposes.

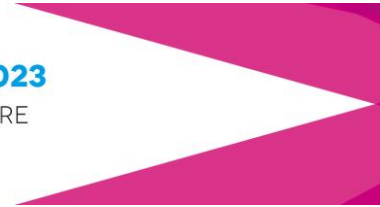

ATHLETE COMPETITION SWIMSUITS

British Divers are required to either wear club costumes or costumes without national team branding. This applies to both GB National Team and International Team branded swim suits (example no international team costumes are permitted).

International divers may wear either their own national team kit or unbranded suits, but not GB National team swim suits.

ACCREDITATION

Accreditation for all competitors and coaches will be photographic. There will be security present at the event and in order to enter both the seating and field of play area you will need accreditation. All divers will be required to submit a **recent passport sized photo** with their online entry. Failure to supply a photograph with the entry forms will result in the entry forms being invalid and therefore not accepted.

If you need to re-print your accreditation on site, a charge of £10.00 applies. Please also note that the event is cashless and only card payment will be accepted on site.

DOPING CONTROL

COACH/CHAPERONE PASSES

All coaches, chaperones and physiotherapists must have a valid photo to gain access to the pool deck. Applications for coach/chaperone passes will charged at £10.00 per event. **A valid DBS check, coaching and safeguarding qualification is required. Coach pass applications are now open [HERE](#)**

Applicants are advised the online Disclosure & Barring Service process could take up to 1 month to complete. All applicants must be registered with an ASA affiliated club.

All ASA clubs and license applicants will have to complete a DBS (CRB) application regardless of any previous check carried out through another organisation unless this has been registered with the DBS Update Service www.gov.uk/db-update-service.
